## NOTICE TO AUTHORS AND COMMUNICATORS

No scientific communication or paper is considered, read, or published by the Royal Society unless it has been communicated by a Fellow or Foreign Member of the Society, whose duty it shall be "to satisfy himself that any letter, report, or other paper which he may communicate is suitable to be read before the Society" (Statute 64, Chapter XII).

Every paper must be accompanied by *three copies* of a brief summary not exceeding 300 words in length.

In view of the necessity for economy, authors of papers submitted to the Royal Society are required to put their communications in as concise a form as possible. MSS. should be type-written, carefully revised and properly prepared as copy for press. It is desirable that authors should retain copies of their MSS. for reference.

Authors are requested to send in all drawings, diagrams or other illustrations in a state suitable for direct photographic reproduction. They should be drawn on a large scale in Indian ink on Bristol board, with temporary lettering in pencil. Great care should be exercised in selecting only those that are essential. If unsatisfactory drawings are submitted Authors may be required to have them redrawn by a professional artist.
